Objectives

To actively develop, name and manage local and regional road assets owned by Kempsey Shire Council for the safety and benefit of residents and visitors.

Policy

- 1 To inspect, monitor and review roads for which the Council is responsible.
- 2 To maintain and upgrade roads and parts of roads within the Shire for which Council is the road authority in accordance with adopted budgets, improvement strategies and programs and the Community Infrastructure Asset Management Strategy/Plan.
- 3 To advocate for and facilitate the maintenance and improvement of roads and related infrastructure that is the responsibility of NSW or federal Government agencies.
- 4 Authority is delegated to Kempsey Shire Council's General Manager to approve suitable road names according to the implemented procedure and criteria for naming roads, pursuant to the provisions of Section 162 of the Roads Act 1993 and Section 9 of the Roads Regulation 2008.
