SUMMARY:

Clause 260 of the Local Government (General) Regulation 2005 provides that: -

"A council may, by resolution, establish such committees as it considers necessary."



Council's present arrangement is to have one (1) standing committee, being the Works Committee.

The Works Committee's function is to carry out inspections of any Council related matters.

The following resolution would be appropriate if the present arrangements are to continue: -

"That a Works Committee comprising the full Council be appointed for the purpose of carrying out inspections of any matters affecting the functions of Council, and that the Works Committee has delegated authority to determine matters provided that the quorum for any meeting of seven (7) members is present, and that Works Committee meetings and inspections be held on a needs basis as determined by Council or the Mayor."
