### SUMMARY:

Reporting on changes required to Council's Events Management Policy C21:22.



In February 2004, Council introduced an Events Management Policy.

The purpose of this policy is to provide an effective mechanism to enable assessment and control of risks presented by public events that are to be held on Council controlled and managed land and or amenity.

To ensure that the policy remains current and practical a review has been undertaken. A copy of the amended policy is attached at [Appendix C](#).

The review identified that additional parties being the NSW Ambulance, NSW Fire Brigade and SES Services are to be advised of events of a significant nature that may affect their operations.

As this policy requires Council consent, it is hereby forwarded to Council for adoption.
