I hereby give notice that I intend to move the following motion at the Ordinary meeting of Kempsey Shire Council to be held on Tuesday, 12th September 2006.

"That Kempsey Shire Council support the inland Councils proposal for a transport road/rail corridor west of the ranges. That we advise the Federal Minister for Transport, The Hon Warren Truss MP and our Local Federal Members The Hon Mark Vaile MP and Mr Luke Hartsuyker MP to support the proposal. That our MIDOC also consider such support at its next meeting."

NOTE:

At the recent Shires conference in Sydney in June 2006 I attended a meeting to discuss a North/South transport Corridor of Road and Rail to move heavy transport off our current roads and en route them via such a corridor west of the ranges.

While the proposal would not have a great benefit for coastal Council's, including ourselves, it would take some of our current and future transport traffic from Victoria, South Australia and Queensland and thereby increase safety on the Pacific Highway.
