SUMMARY:

Reporting on the need to affix Council's seal to Road Closure documents.

DESCRIPTION:

At its meeting on 12TH March 2002, Council considered a report on a proposal to close and transfer the road reserve adjoining the Kempsey Macleay RSL Club and Sub-Branch in Belgrave Street Kempsey. A copy of the report is attached ([Appendix I](#)).

Council resolved:

1. *That the Kempsey-Macleay RSL Club and Kempsey-Macleay Sub-Branch be invited to make an application for road closure and purchase of part of the road reserve currently being used for gardens and access pathways.*
2. *That the RSL Club and Sub-Branch be advised that the conditions of the proposed land transfer would be in accordance with the terms detailed in the Director's Report.*

The survey has now been completed and the Road Closure Plan prepared. Council's seal now needs to be affixed to this Plan so that the road closure and transfer process can proceed.
