SUMMARY:

Reporting on proposals for street names



DESCRIPTION:

A request has been received from Mr John Daley for Hampdendale Pty Ltd to name the roads in the proposed subdivision (Lots 31 & 32) off Crescent Head Road.

It is proposed that road 1, the main road, be named Teague Drive.

This name is after Mr Daley's mother and her parents who have a history on the Macleay of over 100 years. Mr Victor Teague worked for Nestles from approximately 1920 to 1950 as the skipper of one of the launches that collected milk cans from dairy farmers by the river.

It is proposed that road 2, the internal road, be named Daley Crescent

This name is after Mr Daley's father and his parents who also have a history on the Macleay of over 100 years. Mr Daley's grandparents operated a store in West Kempsey in the early 1900's whilst his father worked at Nestles for approximately 30 years prior to his retirement.

These proposed road names have been advertised with no objections received.

Council has received letters from Macleay River Historical Society Inc and from the Department of Lands who have both indicated that they have no objections to the proposed names.

REPORT IMPLICATIONS:

- *Environmental*

Nil.

- *Social*

Naming of roads is required to assist residents in locating properties and addresses.

- *Economic (Financial)*

There are no financial implications as the new signs would be erected by the subdivider.

- *Policy or Statutory*

Under the Roads Act 1993, Part 10, Division 4, Clause 162, a roads authority may name all public roads for which it is the roads authority and must give the Geographical Names Board at least one month's notice of the proposed name. Local roads or streets fall under the jurisdiction of the local council that administers the area.

The Roads (General) Regulation 2000 requires the authority to:

4. Publish notice of its proposal in a local newspaper and
5. Serve notice of its proposal on Australia Post, the Registrar General and the Surveyor General.

The proposed names comply with Council's Policy C 22:6 Street Naming.

- *Director's Review*

Council is asked to adopt the recommendations.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the naming of road 1 as Teague Drive, and road 2 as Daley Crescent in the proposed subdivision off Crescent Head Road be approved.
