**4.1 PLUMMERS LANE, JERSEYVILLE

**4.6 POINT PLOMER RD CRESCENT HEAD-SPEED LIMIT

RECOMMENDATION

That "drive to conditions" gravel road signs be re-erected on Point Plomer Road.

NOTES

RTA advised that gravel roads are not appropriate to speed zone because of the changing nature of the road environment and whilst the State default limit of 100kph is applied to the road, motorists must take responsibility and drive to the conditions of the road.
