I hereby give notice that I intend to move the following motion at the Ordinary meeting of Kempsey Shire Council to be held on Tuesday, 18<sup>th</sup> July 2006.

***"That council gives consideration to the provision of toilet facilities in the draft 2007 - 2008 budget at the John 'Yakka' Watson Reserve Smithtown."***

NOTE:

A public meeting was held in Smithtown, Saturday July 8th, with many speakers in attendance showing concern that the central business district of Smithtown has no accessible public toilets, and that many tourists, fishermen, and families with children that often use the Smithtown wharf and picnic tables were forced to ask shopkeepers and hoteliers for the use of their facilities. Local shopkeepers indicated that they were prepared to unlock and lock toilets if required.
