DSS1	NAMING OF AN EXISTING STREET

SUMMARY:

Reporting on a proposal to name a street.

DESCRIPTION:

At the Council meeting on 13th May 2003 Council resolved to forego renaming a section of the former Belle O'Connor Street as no street numbers would be required in this section.

This street is a section of the old Belle O'Connor Street located next to No. 192 Gregory Street and is currently unnamed. Council has since received a request to name this existing street in South West Rocks [Appendix A – Page H1](#).

This street is only used for vehicular access to No. 192 Gregory Street and to the Country Energy Sub Station. Recently there was an accident at the Sub Station where the Ambulance was called to an injured worker. The location of the Sub Station was unable to be found by the call centre as the street is unnamed.

It is proposed that this section of street be named Keith Andrews Avenue East as it is on the opposite side of Gregory Street to Keith Andrews Avenue.

The financial implication of Council naming this section of street is the need to purchase and erect a street sign. Funding is provided within the current budget for Street Signs.

- *Policy or Statutory*

Under Section 162 of the Roads Act 1993, Council may name all roads for which it is the roads authority. Council must also give notice to the Geographical Names Board.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Council name this unnamed section of old Belle O'Connor Street Keith Andrews Avenue East.
