Department of Ageing, Disability and Home Care

The Department of Ageing Disability and Home Care has requested that the funding variation agreement for an additional \$17,000 for the Kempsey Services Coordinator Project, which will coordinate HACC Services in the Shire, be signed and for Council's seal to be affixed.

REPORT IMPLICATIONS:

The social implication of this report is that a coordinated approach will be provided within the Shire for HACC Services. This is an outcome that has been identified as part of gaps in service provision for older people within the Social Plan.

Council is required to develop and implement a Social Plan. This Social Plan has a number of target areas to address concerns in
