In the event the Rescission Motion is successful it is proposed that the following motion be considered:

- 1. That Council facilitate a meeting of interested stakeholders to consider the preparation of an appropriate Business Plan for the establishment of a Youth Sports Institute for Kempsey Shire.**
- 2. That an approach be made to the –**
 - Department of State and Regional Development;**
 - Department of Sport and Recreation; and**
 - NSW Department of Aboriginal Affairs**

with a request that a financial contribution be made towards the cost of the preparation of the Business Plan.

NOTE:

In respect to the Indoor Sports Centre Committee a meeting has not been held for 3½ years. Kempsey Showground had been identified as an appropriate location and the Plan of Management prepared for the Showground included:

Multi-Purpose Community Centre

- an indoor sports stadium catering for basketball, netball, volleyball, tennis, gymnastics, martial arts, table tennis, boxing, dancing etc
- an indoor 25 metre heated swimming pool
- an exhibition area for Kempsey Show
- a civic centre for balls, concerts, receptions

The current proposal is to investigate the provision of facilities to cover education and training strategies and projects for the Shire's youth initially with the support of the Police and Community Youth Club.

Council must address "Youth" issues to ensure "Economic Development" can progress appropriately.

Council's Community Safety and Crime Prevention Plan 2005 - 2008 states:

- **community consultation indicated a perception that much of Kempsey Shire's crime is committed by youth**
- **the police profile of the "typical" offender also indicated that youth commit crimes out of proportion to other age groups**
- **during the consultation process, young people at both secondary schools in Kempsey indicated that they are aware of how their public activities are viewed by older members of the community and they feel victimised by this. They also acknowledge that, with little organised activity available to them, they tend to "hang out" in town and cause mischief.**

The Kempsey Shire Community Safety and Crime Prevention Plan 2005 - 2008 includes a number of Actions Plans including:

- **Implement and support Kempsey Shire Council's Youth Plan by identifying youth projects and strategies (Plan being developed).**
- **Supporting and promoting activities at the Police and Community Youth Club.**

- *Economic (Financial)*

The estimated cost for the meeting and subsequent contact with the particular authorities is \$300.

The estimated cost of the Business Plan is \$6,000.
