
Business Support Hub - Regional Development Australia MNC



Lodge your next Development or Planning Application online!

As of July 2021 the NSW Government launched a new platform for lodging planning applications in order to create a simpler, faster and more transparent process.

For development applications and most other planning approvals, you can use the NSW Planning

Portal to submit and monitor your application.

For guidance on this process, see Council's advice on using the NSW Planning Portal

The NSW Planning Portal also contains a number of resources to guide and assist you, including:

- A step by step guide on how to register and start using the portal
- A step by step guide on how to lodge a DA on the portal
- <u>Frequently asked questions</u> about technical aspects of the portal, such as password requirements, browser recommendations and accessibility.

The programs, delivered by Destination NSW, will be offered to individuals and businesses wishing to upgrade their customer service skills and enhance their social media capability.


Customer Service Program
